#### A MATTER OF PERSPECTIVE - THE COACH

- Brought in to teach Agile practices and principles
- "Move fast and break things!"
- As company (and code) grew, so did the defect list
- Organized 'Quality Guild'
- In 1 session found a number of defects
- Worried about long-term impact

#### A MATTER OF PERSPECTIVE - THE MERCHANT

- Left Shopify, but created my own store at <u>daverooney.ca</u>
- Acted like typical merchant, creating & formatting store, setting up payment gateway, adding products, etc.
- Never encountered a bug, even though I knew they existed
- A different perspective yielded different results

#### A MATTER OF PERSPECTIVE

- Quality only needs to be good enough, although some areas are more important than others
- Shopify uses continuous delivery
  - If there's a significant problem, they can quickly roll it back or deploy a fix
- The agility that comes with continuous delivery enables both quick fixes AND quick feature delivery
- Shopify is *effective* vs. following Agile

#### WHY EFFECTIVE?

- Software has shipped successfully for decades, even using waterfall approaches
  - There must have been something good in what people did - should we ignore that?
- Every business domain is different, every organization is different, every team is different
  - Why would we expect the same set of practices to apply everywhere?
